OCHS & SMHS

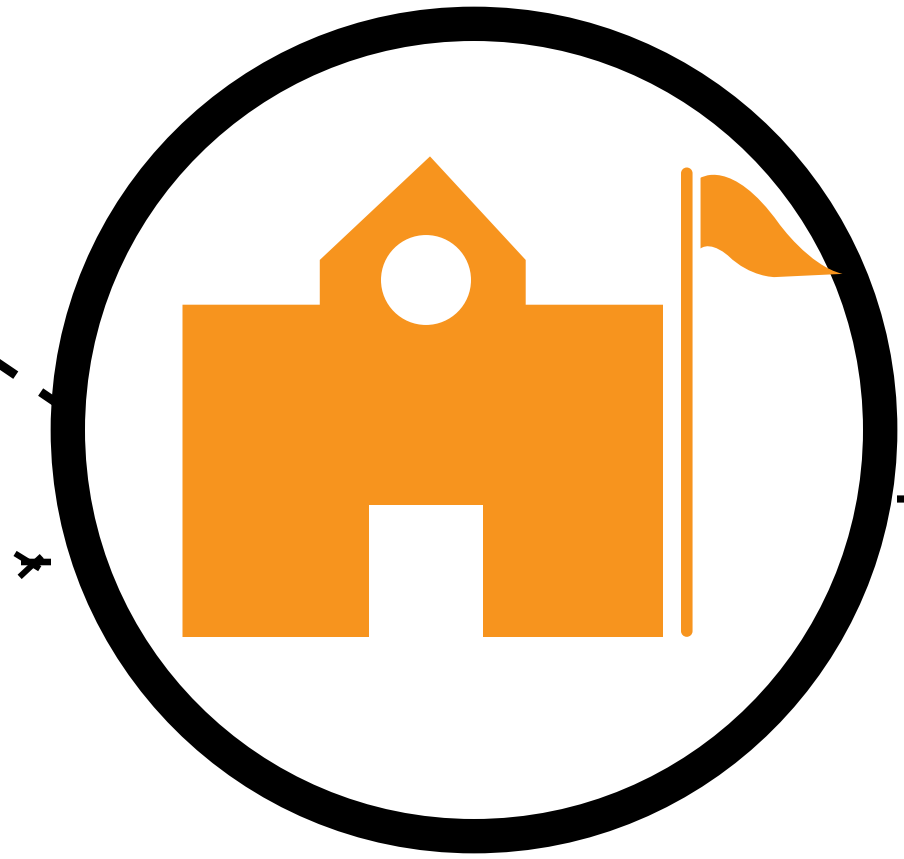
The 2014 Ontario Child Health Study (OCHS) and the School Mental Health Surveys (SMHS) are two separate studies, but they are related.

Ontario Child Health Study

In-home interviews with over 6,500 families across Ontario.

School Mental Health Surveys

Select classes, grades 6-12, from 240 schools across Ontario.

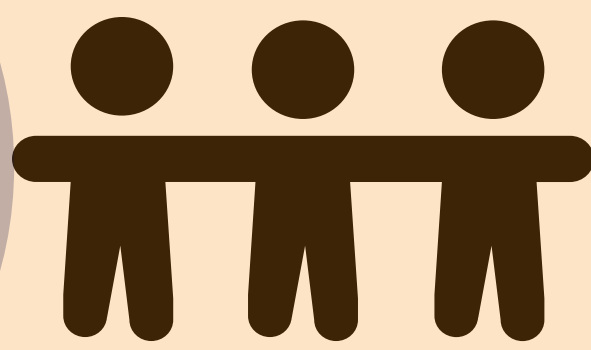


We picked schools for the SMHS from neighbourhoods with families participating in the Ontario Child Health Study



a target youth (ages 12-17) completed the in-home OCHS interview

all grade 6-8 students and random classes in grades 9-12 completed a student survey



the person most knowledgeable about that child, their spouse/partner, and up to 3 siblings were also interviewed

all elementary teachers, and all high school teachers with a class doing the survey, received their own teacher survey



with permission, a questionnaire was also sent to the teachers of elementary-aged children

the principals of selected schools received their own survey



Together, this information will help create a detailed picture of the mental health of children all over Ontario!
